NB: Children will need to bring a mug to school. Parents and caregivers are welcome to come along and watch the event.

We would welcome buckets or containers of ice to be delivered to school tomorrow morning so that the pool temperature can be made as “polar” as possible. Please let your child’s class teacher know if you do not wish your child to have the Milo or chocolate.
