A Reminder Please– (from the school's Attendance Procedure):

Sending Students Home/Early Release:

- Students may not leave the school during school hours except by special arrangement, for example, a parent request (verbal or written) for the student to attend a medical appointment.
- If parents wish to take their child out of school they first go to the school office and check their child out using the electronic (Vistab) machine. **PUPILS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO CHECK THEMSELVES OUT.** A label will be printed out, and parents then take this to the class teacher so they can then collect

their child. Pupils will not be released unless the parent hands this label to the class teacher. Pupils are not to wait at the office or outside at the gate for their parent/s.
